

Conditions Photo contest « Studier på vift »

1) Organizing parties

Campus France Suède, Institut Français de Suède, Atout France Suède.

2) Who can participate?

The contest is aimed at those who have been a student, trainee, or researcher in France within the framework of an exchange program, internship, research stay or a full diploma. The participant must be at least 18 years old and must either have Swedish citizenship or be a resident in Sweden.

3) The objective of the contest

To give the opportunity to alumni who have completed a research stay or university stay in France, to share their experiences. The entries submitted will, after the contest, be used to promote studies and research in France, as part of Campus France Sweden's activities.

4) Entries

The entries are submitted via an online form. The following fields are to be filled out:

1. Name, surname *
2. E-mail address *
3. Postal address
4. Telephone number *
5. Type of stay in France *
6. Period of stay (ex: Jan 2015 – June 2015) *
7. Swedish higher education institution (if you did an exchange or a double degree, for example). If not relevant, type 'no'. *
8. Attach your photo here *
9. Why did you choose this photo? What does it mean to you? *
10. Tell us a funny and/or nice anecdote from your time in France.
11. What is your best advice for those who are considering or planning to go study, do an internship or research in France?
12. I accept that Campus France Sweden and the French Institute in Sweden use my photo together with my first name and my answers to question 5 through 11, to promote studies in France. *

* Mandatory in order to participate. To increase your chances of winning, it is recommended to fill in all the fields.

13. Jury

The entries will be evaluated by members of the French Institute in Sweden and Atout France Sweden, according to the following criteria:

- The entry's value in terms of promoting studies in France
- Motivation for choosing the photo
- Anecdote
- Aesthetics

For each criterion, a score between 1 and 10 will be given by each member of the jury.

5) The winner

The entry that has received the highest number of points (the sum of the jury's votes) will be named the winning entry. If more than one entry receives the highest number of points, the jury will vote to select the winning entry.

6) First prize

The first prize consists of a trip for two from Sweden to France, for five days. The program for the trip is organized and tailored by Campus France Sweden in consultation with the winner:

- Visit to a French institution of higher education and/or a French laboratory
- Cultural and tourist visits

Thus, the winner will have the chance to make academic contacts in France and exchange experiences about studies and research in the two respective countries, on the theme that they prefer.

The following expenses will be covered, with a maximum amount of 750€ per person:

- Round-trip flights, Sweden-France, average total price: 250€
- 4 to 5 nights in a hotel, average total price: 350 €
- Food and drink, average total price: 150€

NOTE: The prevailing epidemic forces the French Institute in Sweden to wait with all travels to France until travel restrictions are eased between Sweden and France (PCR test, quarantine, etc.). The French Institute's decision to complete the trip can be made no later than October 1, 2021 and the trip itself must take place before November 15, 2021. If the trip cannot be completed, a replacement prize will be awarded to the winner.

The replacement prize for the winner and its chosen plus one, will be decided if this becomes necessary, and the replacement prize will, in terms of the price, be equal to the original prize.

7) Second and third prize



The second and third prizes will be a one-year subscription to Culturthèque, the French Institute's digital library.

8) Coup de cœur du public

During the event for the award ceremony, each participant present will be able to vote for their favorite entry. The entry that receives the most votes from the guests will get the title "Coup de cœur du public" (= Public's choice).

10) Dissemination of the entries

The entries from the contest will be shown during France Alumni Sweden's event on June 4, 2021. They will be used to implement:

- A traveling exhibition at institutions for higher education, other educational institutions, Alliances Françaises in Sweden, etc. starting in the autumn of 2021.
- A digital album
- Other projects for the promotion of higher education and research in France, within the activities of Campus France Sweden.
